### **Information sheet for students from Ukraine, Belarus and Russia for the participation in German language courses**

In response to the current situation, *treffpunkt sprachen* – Centre for Language, Plurilingualism and Didactics at the University of Graz offers German language courses for students from Ukraine, Belarus and Russia. #### **Enrolment, confirmation of enrolment, student ID card – what to do:**

1) Enrolment at the Office for Academic Affairs (Universitaetsplatz 3a, opposite the main library) at the University of Graz with valid personal documents, a respective residence card according to Austrian Asylum Law or travel documents. 2) Until further notice displaced people from Ukraine do not have to pay tuition fees. Students studying at the University of Graz from Belarus and Russia, who are verifiably influenced by their home countries' payment restrictions can have their tuition fees waived.

The Austrian Students' Union fee ("ÖH-Beitrag"), for students from Ukraine, Belarus and Russia, will be covered by the University of Graz or the Students' Union if bank transfer difficulties occur.

3) You will receive a **student e-mail address** when first enrolling at the University of Graz. Please, check your inbox regularly.

4) You can upload an ID- picture to UNIGRAZonline which will be used for your **student ID card** (UNIGRAZCard) and doubles as a **library card** (passport format, high resolution).

5) You can download and print your **confirmation of enrolment** directly in UNIGRAZonline. Students from Ukraine, Belarus and Russia can use this document as proof of admission and to enrol in a German language course. Please contact Mag.
